We need new members. Invite someone to a free lunch & let them decide if they want to become a member.

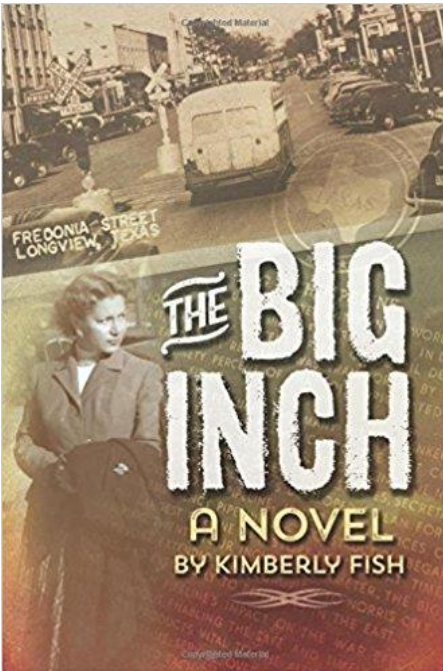
World HQ Maintenance
