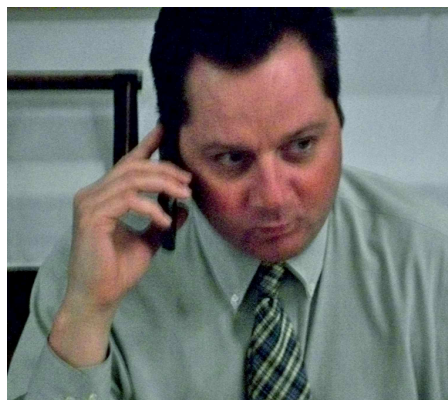

### Vice Prez Doug Fouse March Business Meeting (Piece o' cake for a salesman!)

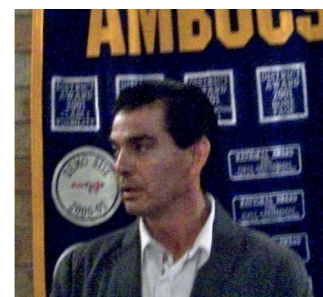
March 19<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting:
