Mike also updated us on our club points, saying we are in 2nd place, behind Irving. In 3rd place is southwest Texas. Because we spark plugged a new club, our points have climbed dramatically. He challenged us to finish # 1 in the nation like we have done so many times.

Dr. Pyle spoke of the recent improvements there, most notably being their new Health Sciences building, financed by a \$35M bond program. Even though it amounted to a tax increase of 39%, an overwhelming 84% of voters approved it. It opens in July 2015. This shows the faith of the community in supporting the college, especially the nursing and health sciences. The last bond election was in 1948. He spoke of the many medical and vocational programs available, and the current student enrollment of 2.700 credit students and 1.600 continuing education students. 250 students reside on campus in 3 dormitory halls built in 2005, and a 4th completed in 2013. Building renovations are scheduled, including a new Student Ctr & Gvm. He was proud of the fact that scholarships are split evenly

between athletics and academics.
