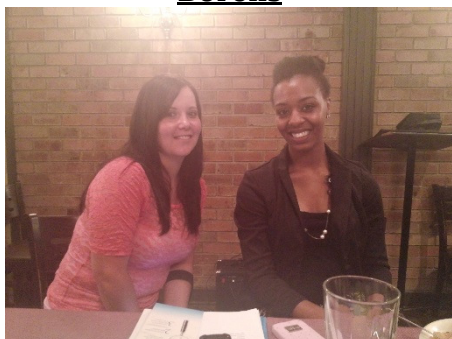
classified as an AMBUCS fundraiser so it can be covered under the insurance policy. Motion passed.
